



WOUND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

1. During your appointment, you will have a bandage placed on the affected area, please leave that on for a full 24 hours.
2. After that 24 hours is complete, remove bandage and wash area with soap and water
3. Apply antibiotic ointment such as bacitracin, polysporin or aquaphor
4. Cover with another appropriately sized bandage that seals on 4 sides

It's normal for the area to appear red and inflamed for several days. However, if you experience a fever, chills, or notice the area becoming excessively warm, swollen, and tender to touch, please contact our office immediately at 315-663-0100.
